This contest is organized with the help of Antibes Juan les Pins City Hall and Port Gallice.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 1.3 The concerned class rules, this notice of race, the race instructions
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.2 Boats may be required to display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all of the boats from the following series: Laser Standard and Radial.

Age Group	Masters Category
35 to 44	Laser Standard Apprentice Master Laser Radial Apprentice Master
45 to 54	Laser Standard Master Laser Radial Master
55 to 64	Laser Standard Grand Master Laser Radial Grand Master
65 and over	Laser Standard Great Grand Master (men only)
65 à 74	Laser Radial Great Grand Master
75 and over	Laser Radial Legend



- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and sending it, together with the required fee to Société des Régates d'Antibes or completing the digital form with the required fee available on our website.
- 3.3 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: late entry fee of 100 €
- 3.5 The competitors (each crew member) living in France must present during registration :
- the valid and signed FFVoile's licence with health certificate.
 - A valid authorization to display advertising on boat, if necessary.
- The measurement form or certificate of the boat,
Foreign competitors without a French license shall justify their membership to a World Sailing Member national authority and shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of 2 000 000 Euros.

4. CLASSIFICATION

No classification requirement is needed for this regatta.

5. FEES

Required fees are as follows:

Entry fee: 85 € up to Wednesday 9th of January

Late entry fee: 100 € after that date

The fees include a crew dinner, the boat parking and the car parking from Wednesday to Sunday. Additional dinner tickets are available for 20 € each.

6. QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

No qualifying series and final series will be applied for this regatta.

7. SCHEDULE

- 7.1 Registration confirmation at Port Gallice (Juan les Pins) Wednesday January, 16th from 3:00PM to 7:00PM, Thursday January 17th from 10:00AM to 7:00 PM and Friday 18th from 9:00AM to 11:30AM.

- 7.3 Dates of racing:

- 7.6 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 3:30 pm

- 7.7 SKI in Auron :
- A giant slalom (Flèche ESF) will takes place at Auron ski station at 12:00 noon on thursday 17th with complimentary champagne at the bottom of the ski-slopes.
 - A voucher to purchase a discounted ski pass can be obtained at registration time at Port Gallice until Wednesday 7:00 pm.
 - Last minute registrations for the ski competition can be made in Auron until 11:45 am Thursday before the start of the race.
 - All crew and staff can compete but only the best time of the crew will be used for the score of the boat.
- 7.8 Crew dinner will be on **Saturday** at 7:30 pm at the SRA Club House, Port Vauban, Antibes
- 7.9 Each evening after the race, open bar and hot chocolate.

8. MEASUREMENT

- 8.2 A boat shall comply with RSS 78.1 as required by class rules.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions and their appendices will be available during the registration confirmation.

10. VENUE

- 10.1 Port Gallice in Antibes Juan les Pins.

11. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows: windward/leeward or trapeze.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 12.2 RSS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

13. SCORING

- 13.2 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 13.3(a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from 4 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

14. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be identified with a red flag. [DP]

15. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

18. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones. [DP]

19. PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows as soon as possible after the last race on Sunday:

Laser Apprentice Standard (35 to 44 years)

Laser Master Standard (45 to 54 years)

Laser Grand Master Standard (55 to 64 years)

Laser Great Grand Master Standard (65 and over)

Laser Radial Fleet:

Laser Apprentice Radial Men (35 to 44 years)

Laser Apprentice Radial Women (35 to 44 years)

Laser Master Radial Men (45 to 54 years)

Laser Master Radial Women (45 to 54 years)

Laser Grand Master Radial Men (55 to 64 years)

Laser Grand Master Radial Women (55 to 64 years)

Laser Great Grand Master Radial Men (from 65 to 74)

Laser Great Grand Master Radial Women (from 65 to 74)

Laser Legend 75 and over

Laser Women Overall

20. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RSS 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

21. INSURANCE

Each foreign competitor without FFVoile licence shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 2 000 000 € per incident or the equivalent.

All boats must have onboard the totality of the security equipment required by their own class rules and the french rules one's.

22.2 Boat storage

Boats will be parked at Port Gallice, Juan les Pins.
